LOCATION: With views of the Pacific Ocean and nearby islands of Balboa, Lido and Catalina, this 20-story, 295-room hotel is situated in the heart of Newport Center – the business address of Newport Beach and Orange County – and adjacent to Fashion Island, the area’s premier outdoor regional shopping and restaurant center. Newport Beach is one of the toniest resort beach cities in Southern California and is located midway between Los Angeles and San Diego.

OPENED: May 29, 1986. The owner, Irvine Company, assumed management November 1, 2005 and renamed the property Island Hotel Newport Beach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Recently redone to play off Newport Beach's oceanfront locale, the 295 guestrooms include 64 Executive Suites and 19 more spacious Luxury Suites.

With garden or sweeping coastline panoramas, accommodations are light and airy and richly appointed in subtle sage, camel, taupe and yellow shades – and re-outfitted with luxurious new carpeting and draperies, rich wood furnishings, polished marble and honed granite accents. Exquisite plein air works by contemporary California artists were commissioned to complement the breezy new décor.

RATES: Guestroom rates range from \$385 for a lower-level room to \$535 for a higher-level room. One and two-bedroom suites range from \$585 to \$5,500.

**DINING/
ENTERTAINMENT:**

Palm Terrace Restaurant & Lounge debuted in June 2007, after an extensive two-month renovation. The new name reflects the palm leaf motif and “tropical oasis” feel of the décor. Other highlights include: Chef Bill Bracken’s American-style cuisine, including his signature “small bites”; and live entertainment in the Lounge. A seasonal poolside eatery, the Palapa Bar, is also available, as is 24-hour in-room dining.

**SPA & FITNESS
FACILITIES:**

Opened in 2005, The Spa at Island Hotel features nine treatment rooms for massages, body treatments and facials. Nail services are also available. Separate male and female locker rooms feature: a relaxation room with complimentary waters and fruits; shower and vanity area; and steam room.

CONTINUED:**

Signature rituals take spa-goers on an exotic global island voyage to awaken the senses and reinvigorate the body, such as the: Island Boreh Bali Spice Remedy; Island Volcanic Detoxifying Wrap; and Island Tropical Splendor.

The complimentary fitness facilities are located adjacent to the pool, and feature new Life Fitness treadmills, Lifecycles, recumbent Lifecycle, Stairmaster 4000 and Life Fitness weight equipment. Personal trainers are also available.

TENNIS:

Two outdoor lighted tennis courts are available for complimentary use. A tennis instructor is available for private lessons upon request.

GOLF:

Pelican Hill Golf Club, owned and operated by Irvine Company, re-opened November 2007 along Newport Coast. The renowned Ocean North and Ocean South courses were originally opened in 1991, and have been recently re-perfected by original course designer Tom Fazio.

SHOPPING:

Nearby Fashion Island offers over 200 specialty shops and restaurants – including Orange County’s only Neiman Marcus – as well as movie cinemas and a Venetian carousel.

Located just minutes away from Newport Harbor and the Pacific Ocean, nearby water activities include: waterskiing, windsurfing, sailing, surfing, scuba diving, deep sea diving and electric boat rides.
